


Studies have found that screening with a simple PSA blood test could mean that fewer men die from prostate cancer.

the errol mckellar story



My journey with prostate cancer started in 2010 quite by chance when I went to see my GP about something else. My wife had been complaining that my snoring was making it difficult for her to get off to sleep, so I went to talk to my doctor to discuss possible treatments.

Whilst waiting in the surgery, I picked up a leaflet about PSA blood testing for prostate cancer. I decided to make an appointment to come back and get the test done but the receptionist said to me "...an appointment isn't necessary, this is a simple blood test that takes less than 10 minutes and we can do this now."

I took the test immediately and a week later, I was called back for a repeat blood test as something had flagged up. Another week passed and I was called in for a biopsy, followed quickly by a scan. I was given an appointment to see a consultant and he told my wife and I that my prostate was covered in cancer. I got up and walked out of the room and went

back to my car. Frightened, helpless, lost, I sat there and burst into tears.

After speaking with my wife, I went back to the room and the consultant highlighted the severity of the cancer by informing us that if it was not removed, I could die within six months. My options were an operation or radiotherapy. I had the operation (radical prostatectomy) but the cancer had started to spread, as a result I was given 28 days of radiotherapy.

Spreading Awareness

I was a mechanic and MOT tester and was out of work for six months. In my first week back at work, a man came in to the garage to have some work

done on his car and we spoke about the reason for my absence. During our chat, I had asked him when was the last time he had his prostate checked. He gave me a peculiar look and questioned the relevance of that question in relation to his gearbox. Without thinking, I said to him "if you go and get your test done I will give you 20% discount on the work repairs on the car."

Two weeks later the same man came back in to the garage, waiving a piece of paper in his hand and said "I took your advice" and my first thought was 'oh no this has just cost me £200.' After seeing the shock in my face he said "I don't want you to give me any money, I would rather you donate it to charity but I think you need to read this." When I looked at the letter he had 25% cancer in his prostate.

He was the first of the 48 men who came into my garage who was diagnosed with prostate related issues.





We plan to do this through launching a mobile PSA blood testing vehicles to enable and encourage men over 45 to have their PSA blood test in their local area without impacting the overworked NHS. It's vital that men are tested and they are aware a simple blood test could save their life.

Background on Prostate Cancer

- in eight men in the UK, one in 12 men from an Asian background and one in four men from a black African or Caribbean background. We aim to reach out to men in those communities.
- Prostate cancer is the most common cancer in men and it was recently announced that for the first time in the UK more men are dying of prostate cancer than breast cancer kills women.
- Over 47,000 men are diagnosed with prostate cancer every year that's 129 men every day. Every 45 minutes, one man dies from prostate cancer - that's more than 11,000 men every year. Over 330,000 men are living with and after prostate cancer.



Given that one in eight men in the UK are affected by prostate cancer, it is surprising that there is no national screening program in the UK, We wouldn't leave the health of our cars to chance like this - it is a legal requirement to MOT them every year.

The test measures the level of prostate-specific antigen (PSA) in your blood. PSA is a protein made only by the prostate gland. Some of it leaks into your blood, but how much depends on your age and the health of your prostate.

You have the right to a PSA test if you are over 50. If you're black or you have a family history of prostate cancer, this can increase your personal risk - so you may want to consider asking for a PSA test earlier, from the age of 45.

PSA blood testing vehicles

We want to launch mobile PSA blood testing vehicles, which will be based in various locations nationally for at least 48 weeks in the year. Designed with COVID-19 specifications in place.

- These vehicles will enable and encourage men to have a PSA blood test at least once a year.
- Not only will this service alleviate the pressure on our currently overworked NHS service, it will ensure that men take control of their well-being and give them peace of mind. It's a simple blood test!
- Results will be available within 48 hours via text and/or email with potentially shorter waiting times once the service is established.
- To build, fit, and run one vehicle for two years it will cost in the region of £1.1m.
- We will create jobs for specialist nurses, receptionists, class two drivers, administrators, and medical advisors.
- For the first year we can test as many as 10,000 people, and more with greater funding.
- With the assistance of an app, designed especially for The Errol McKellar Foundation, men will be able to pre-book appointments for a PSA test when the unit is in their location.
- Once the first mobile unit is built and on the road, every further £10,000 will ensure that 2,000 men will be tested!





- We will operate a simple traffic light system, and the unit will contain a nurse, who will be able to point people in the right direction for future steps (if necessary).




